

Wegmans is coming to New York City

Wegmans will open its first New York City location this fall.

The highly-anticipated Brooklyn Navy Yard store will occupy a 74,000 square-foot space on Flushing Avenue in the Admirals Row development.

The supermarket will include a second-floor mezzanine with nearly 100 seats for an in-store cafe and bar.

"Wegmans stores have a European open-air market look and feel, offering an abundance of choice, the best ingredients, thousands of organic options, restaurant-quality prepared food, and consistent low prices," a representative wrote in a statement announcing the opening.

The chain said out of the 500 workers they hope to employ, 150 will be full-time positions. The majority of the employees will be hired locally.
