## Wegmans reveals opening date for Brooklyn Navy Yard market

The first city Wegmans grocery store will open its doors Oct. 27.

The Rochester-based company revealed the official opening date Wednesday morning for its much-anticipated Brooklyn Navy Yard store. The 74,000-square-foot supermarket is under construction on Admiral's Row along Flushing Avenue in the 300-acre Navy Yard.

More than 60,000 products will fill the store's shelves, including a specialty counter with 350 varieties of cheese and an assortment of take-home meals created with help from celebrity chef David Bouley, as detailed in April. A second-floor mezzanine in the market will house a café and a bar.

Wegmans said it still hiring and training for 350 part-time and 150 full-time positions at the store. The grocery chain has just under 100 locations, focused mostly in upstate New York and along the East Coast. The closest market the company currently operates to the city is in Woodbridge, New Jersey.

Arrive early if you want to be first to see the store. The official opening is scheduled for 7 a.m.
